

Cops push cyber café security

Bengaluru: The city police has, in a bid to crack down on cyber crime, endorsed the use of a cyber café security management and accounting software that digitally records data of customers at browsing centres.

At an interactive session on cyber crime on Thursday, held by the city police and Ideacts Innovations, joint commissioner of police (crime) Alok Kumar said cyber cafés constitute more than 47 per cent of the access points for Internet use in the country and these browsing centres have become convenient places for criminals and terrorists to use the Web.
