

CLINCK to keep tab on internet users

BANGALORE: An interactive session of the police and cyber cafe owners was held, to make them aware of the misuse of cyber space for criminal activities and difficulties in reporting them, on Thursday.

Cyber cafes account for 47 per cent of access point for internet usage in India and have thus emerged as hotspots of cyber crimes.
